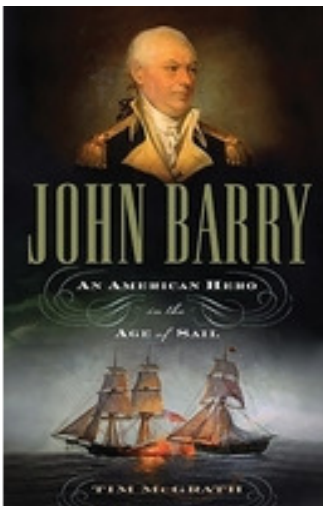

Do You Know for Whom the Commodore Barry Bridge is Named?

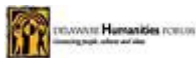
Commodore John Barry was the first to capture a British war vessel on the high seas. He captured over 20 ships including an armed British schooner in the lower Delaware; quelled three mutinies, fought on land at the Battles of Trenton and Princeton and he fought the last naval battle of the American Revolution aboard the frigate *Alliance* in 1783. John Barry is considered the father of the American Navy.
